

Resolution 2025-25
Surplus Equipment/Asset Deletion/ Solid Waste

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department is in possession of the following equipment: one (1) #417 Recycle Truck, 2008 Sterling LT95000, VIN2FZHYZC47AY45933, Asset #4661, which has outlived its usefulness to the County; and

WHEREAS, the equipment described hereinabove is in excess of \$250.00, and has not been offered to other County Departments as the equipment is specific for Solid Waste needs; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department desires to have the equipment declared as surplus property, deleted from its asset list, and disposed of;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the equipment referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by another means, in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Eberlein, the following vote was recorded:


