

Resolution 2025-45
Kootenai County Emergency Medical Services System Fee Increase
Standby Rate for Events

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners, acting in its capacity as the governing board of Kootenai County Ambulance District, is authorized under *Idaho Code* § 31-3904 and § 63-1311 to set fees for service within Kootenai County; and

WHEREAS, legal notice was published and a public hearing was held as required per *Idaho Code* § 63-1311A; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Commissioners that the Kootenai County Emergency Medical Services System (KCEMSS) continue to be supported, to the extent possible, by user fees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to ensure that the quality of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) in Kootenai County remains high; and

WHEREAS, KCEMSS charges a fee for dedicated ambulance standbys for events in Kootenai County that require an ambulance to be on scene for the duration of an event such as concerts, races and rodeos which require dedicated standbys for these events which are personnel called back on overtime to cover these events; and

WHEREAS, the current rate charged for dedicated ambulance standbys for events in Kootenai County, which was last set in 2023, is not high enough to cover the full cost to staff and equip these ambulances for such events;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the rate for dedicated ambulance standbys for events in Kootenai County shall be, and is hereby increased from \$165.00 per hour to \$261.85 per hour, effective immediately.




