

**Resolution 2024-19**  
**Acceptance of Donation – Funds to Purchase FARO Laser Measurement Tool/KCSO**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to receive real and personal property in donation, and to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Sheriff's Employee Association Inc. desires to donate funds to the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office Traffic Team for the purchase of a FARO Laser Measurement tool which will streamline measurements of active vehicle crash scenes, saving time and resources for the Sheriff's Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office would use the property purchased with the donation hereinabove in its normal course of business;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that Kootenai County does hereby accept the gift/donation of the funds referenced hereinabove on behalf of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office.

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that the property purchased with the donated funds shall be assigned an asset tag and added to Kootenai County's list of assets as maintained by the Kootenai County Clerk/Auditor in its regular course of business.

## DONATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2024 by and between a private donor and Kootenai County (hereinafter the "County").

WHEREAS, Kootenai County, through the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, provides law enforcement services in Kootenai County; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Deputy Sheriff's Association, Inc., a private party residing in Coeur d' Alene, Kootenai County, Idaho desires to donate funds to the Sheriff's Office Employee Association to purchase a FARO Laser Measurement tool for the Sheriff's Office Traffic Team; and

WHEREAS the Kootenai County Sheriff's Employee Association (FOP Lodge #43) desires to purchase a FARO Laser Measurement tool for the use of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office Traffic Team as it will streamline obtaining measurements of active accident scenes, saving time and resources; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office to accept the funds to be utilized to purchase equipment for law enforcement personnel;

NOW THEREFORE, in mutual consideration of the needs of the parties, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. That the Kootenai County Deputy Sheriff's Association, Inc. hereby agrees to donate funds to the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office for the purchase of a FARO Laser Measurement tool to be used by the Sheriff's Office Traffic Team.
2. That the donation of the funds is being made by the Kootenai County Deputy Sheriff's Association, Inc. to the County without consideration.
3. That Kootenai County agrees to accept the donation of the funds for use to purchase equipment for the use of the Sheriff's Office Traffic Team.
