

**Resolution 2024-50**  
**Surplus Vehicles/Asset Deletion/Airport**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coeur d'Alene Airport has on its asset list several vehicles and pieces of heavy equipment (see attached Exhibit "A") which are obsolete due to age, have outlived their useful life and/or are fully depreciated, and of no further use to the Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicles and heavy equipment described listed on Exhibit "A" have a value in excess of \$250.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the sale of these vehicles/heavy equipment would generate revenue for the Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, sale of property belonging to an airport that received funding from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) must retain all proceeds from disposal in accordance with Airport Sponsor's Assurance # 25(a)-Airport Revenues, which states:

"All revenues generated by the airport and any local taxes on aviation fuel established after December 30, 1987, will be expended by it for the capital or operating costs of the airport; the local airport system; or other local facilities which are owned or operated by the owner or operator of the airport and which are directly and substantially related to the actual transportation of passengers or property; or for noise mitigation purposes on or off the airport."; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coeur d'Alene Airport desires to have the vehicles/heavy equipment declared as surplus property, and as such to be disposed of at public auction, and all proceeds returned to the Airport Fund (Fund 30);

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the vehicles/heavy equipment described on Exhibit "A" be and hereby are declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, said vehicles/heavy equipment shall be sold at public auction to the highest bidder, after advertising the same as surplus property in accordance with *Idaho Code* 31-808.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Mattare, the following vote was recorded:


