

Resolution 2024-52
Surplus Equipment/Juvenile Diversion

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that a board of county commissioners shall have the power and authority to sell or offer for sale at public auction any real or personal property belonging to the county not necessary for its use. However, personal property not exceeding two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) in value may be sold at private sale without notice or public auction.

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Diversion is in possession of one (1) Ricoh Aficio MP 6002SP, Asset # 5814, Serial Number W82L600115

WHEREAS, the equipment described hereinabove is in excess than \$250.00, and a board of county commissioners shall have the power and authority to sell or offer for sale at public auction any real or personal property belonging to the county not necessary for its use; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Diversion desires to have the equipment declared as surplus property, deleted from its asset list, and disposed of pursuant to law;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.


