

Resolution 2024-58
Surplus Vehicle/Asset Deletion/KCSO

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has on its asset list one (1) 2017 Ford Explorer Police Interceptor, VIN 1FM5K8AR5HGB83020, Asset #7548, which was in an accident and was totaled, and is of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle described hereinabove has no value; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office desires to have the vehicle declared as surplus property, and as such to be disposed of by the County by turning over the vehicle to the County's insurer for disposal;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the vehicles described hereinabove be and hereby is declared to be surplus property and of no value, and that said vehicle shall be disposed of by delivery to the County's insurer, ICRMP.
