

**Resolution 2024-72
Destroy Records/KCSO Patrol**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires a resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of Kootenai County Sheriff, Patrol Division, has been performed, and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of Kootenai County Sheriff, Patrol Division attached as “Exhibit A” and incorporated into Resolution 2024-71 adopted on October 8th, 2024 are authorized to be destroyed.
