

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-82
EXCHANGE OR TRADE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY
KOOTENAI COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has in its possession the following pistols:

- (16) Glock 17 MOS pistols, serial numbers:
BKFL487, BKFL519, BKFL520, BKFL531, BKUL680, BKFL621, BKFL627,
BKFL628, BKFL630, BKUL697, BKUL701, BKUL709, BKUL706, BKUL710,
BWAE123, BKZD063

WHEREAS, the pistols identified above were utilized for several years prior as weapons by Sheriff's Office personnel in the course and scope of their law enforcement duties; and,

WHEREAS, the pistols identified above are of no further use to the Sheriff's Office for law enforcement purposes, as they have higher than average wear and tear and have seen far greater use than other pistols of the same vintage within the agency, and as such, are past their useful lives; and,

WHEREAS, Sheriff's Office personnel had the pistols inspected and valued by a local gun dealer, Gunarama Wholesale Inc., and the dealer has established that the approximate value of the equipment is \$300 per pistol, or \$4,800 aggregate value for all sixteen pistols; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Sheriff's Office to trade the pistols identified above for new Glock 47 pistols at \$481 each, total price of \$7,696, as the used pistols would have a greater value on trade than upon auction and/or private sale; and,

WHEREAS, Gunarama Wholesale Inc., a gun dealer located at 4009 E Mission Ave, Spokane, WA 99202, has offered to take the identified pistols in trade as stated above; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consents to the sale/trade of the pistols as described hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to trade the pistols as identified hereinabove for the new pistols offered through Gunarama Wholesale Inc.


