

Resolution No. 2024-91
Sole Source Procurement of Camera and Door AC Systems
for the Justice Building Expansion Project

At a meeting of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners (“the Board”), on the 10th day of December, 2024, the following Resolution was adopted, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the Board is charged with the duty and responsibility to provide security systems for all County buildings which are open to the public and other County buildings in which security systems are necessary or desirable; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore the Boards’s duty and responsibility to fully and properly equip all County buildings housing courtrooms, judges, court staff, and the prosecuting attorney, deputy prosecuting attorneys and staff, with adequate security systems; and

WHEREAS, this duty also includes ensuring that any security systems installed in new or expanded buildings are compatible with existing security systems in existing buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to secure an agreement with Access Unlimited and Security, Inc., 2615 N. Cincinnati Street, Suite 101, Spokane, WA 99207, to obtain Camera and Door AC Systems for the Kootenai County Justice Building Expansion Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code § 67-2808(2)(a)(ii), the Board is permitted to use sole source procurement where the compatibility of equipment, components, accessories, computer software, replacement parts, or service is the paramount consideration; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds and declares that the procurement of the above-referenced category of items which will be compatible with the already existing security equipment throughout the Courthouse Campus, including the existing Justice Building, is required to maintain compatibility of equipment, components, accessories, computer software, replacement parts, and associated services, concerning the compatibility of the items to be purchased with each other and also with existing equipment owned by the County which will continue to be used; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code § 67-2808(2)(a)(viii), the Board is permitted to use sole source procurement where competitive solicitation is impractical, disadvantageous or unreasonable under the circumstances; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the above-named vendor is the sole source for the category of items referenced above;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board does hereby intend to contract with the above-named vendor as the sole source vendor to provide the category of items referenced above for the County’s Justice Center Expansion project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect retroactive to December 3, 2024.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Mattare, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:
