Surplus Equipment/Asset Deletion/Veterans Services Office

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property valued at less than \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Veterans Services Office has in its possession one (1) Ricoh MP400ISP Copier, Asset #4962 which is not usable and was found to have been removed by the vendor during a physical audit; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total value of the equipment listed above is less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Veterans Services Office desires to have the above-referenced item declared as surplus, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the County's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.
