

Resolution 2023-54
Kootenai County Sheriff/Peace Officer and Detention Deputy Protection

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §67-5340 provides certain protection for employees of the State who are categorized as police officers who are physically disabled by a serious injury or illness arising out of their duties, and the injury is induced by a second party; and,

WHEREAS, out of respect and appreciation for those that protect us each day, Kootenai County wishes to afford the same protection to our patrol deputies, detention deputies and animal control officers, but limited to a period of not more than six (6) months of benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Kootenai County adopts, with the above extension and limitations, the provisions of *Idaho Code* §67-5340 for the above described County employees, effective May 16, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall supersede and repeal Resolutions 2017-41 and 1994-48, and any other previously enacted resolution pertaining to the same subject matter, and shall be effective as of the date of signature below.
