

Resolution 2021-02
Cancellation of Taxes, Penalties, Interest and Filing Fees
Kootenai County Surplus Property
Parcel No. 01418001001B /AIN 173521

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners are aware that the listed parcel in Exhibit "A" is under ownership of the County. Kootenai County, a government entity is tax exempt; therefore, the Commissioners' are requesting a cancellation of the taxes, penalties, interest and filing fees on the referenced parcel, record owner being Kootenai County, 451 N. Government Way, Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai County, ID; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Commissioners' requested that the taxes, penalties, interest and filing fees be cancelled on the referenced parcel for the outstanding balance listed individually within Exhibit "A" for the tax years through and including 2010 as the County has decided to keep the listed surplus property and needs to perform a record cleanup for accurate accounting; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners on January 6, 2021 at a properly noticed public meeting, agreed to cancel the outstanding balance of taxes, penalties, interest and filing fees excluding Aquifer and Forest Protection fees through and including 2010 tax years; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the outstanding balance of taxes, penalties, interest and filing fees for all tax years up to and including 2010 will be cancelled; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Assessor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said Resolution.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Brooks, the following vote was recorded:




