

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-19

**DONATION OF BOAT, TRAILER AND RADAR EQUIPMENT TO
BONNER COUNTY/KOOTENAI COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that the board of county commissioners may, at its discretion, grant to or exchange with any political subdivision, with or without compensation, any property owned by the county, after adoption of a resolution by the board of county commissioners that the grant or exchange of property is in the public interest; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office (hereinafter the "Sheriff") has in its possession a boat, trailer and radar equipment more particularly described as follows:

Asset No. 1274	1990 Almar 21' AUC229611990 Boat, ID2787U, with inboard/outboard motor
Asset No. 1284	1989 EZ Loader 21' Trailer, 1ZEQTLZ2XKAN34704
Asset No. 04915	Raytheon R10xx Surface Radar, Serial No. LN23384

WHEREAS, the boat was acquired on June 6, 1992, for \$32,532 and has a current estimated value of \$6,000; the trailer was acquired on April 17, 1990, for \$2,500 and has a current estimated value of \$1,000; and the radar equipment was acquired on September 9, 1996, for \$5,628.86, and has been fully depreciated and has no current value; and,

WHEREAS, the property/equipment hereinabove referenced has been replaced by the Sheriff due to its age and mechanical issues and therefore is of no further use to the Sheriff and his law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, the property/equipment referenced hereinabove is presently listed on Kootenai County's asset list which is maintained by the Kootenai County Auditor's Office. It is the desire of the Sheriff to have the property/equipment referenced hereinabove declared as surplus property and then donated to Bonner County for use by its law enforcement personnel; and,

RESOLUTION - 1

WHEREAS, notice of this proposed transfer was published in the Coeur d'Alene Press on March 9, 2021 and March 16, 2021; and,

WHEREAS, upon donation, the Sheriff desires to have the property/equipment hereinabove referenced removed from Kootenai County's asset list.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the property/equipment described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property in accordance with Idaho law.



Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


