

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-29

**DONATION OF 1988 FORD 1-TON PICKUP AND 2005
POLARIS SNOWMOBILE TO SILVER VALLEY SEARCH &
RESCUE/KOOTENAI COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, through its Search & Rescue Unit (hereinafter the "Sheriff") has in its possession one 1988 Ford 1-Ton Pickup, Serial No. 2FDLF47G8JCA8848 SO718, and a 2005 Polaris Snowmobile, 700RMK151, Serial No. SN1NL7CSX5C544334, which were acquired by the Sheriff as equipment to be utilized by its Search & Rescue Unit; and

WHEREAS, the 1988 Ford 1-Ton Pickup had a value of approximately \$4,500 at the time of acquisition through donation, but the vehicle has not been used by the Search & Rescue Unit and has depreciated over the years and has little or no present value; and

WHEREAS, the 2005 Polaris Snowmobile was purchased in 2005 for \$7,173. Since its acquisition, the snowmobile has encountered major engine issues rendering it inoperable and of no further use by and the Search & Rescue Unit. Further, the snowmobile has depreciated and has little or no present value; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Sheriff to have the above referenced 1988 Ford 1-Ton Pickup and the 2005 Polaris Snowmobile declared as surplus property and then donated to Silver Valley Search & Rescue for use by its members.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the 1988 Ford 1-Ton Pickup and 2005 Polaris Snowmobile referenced hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items in accordance with Idaho law.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners consents to the donation of the 1988 Ford 1-Ton Pickup and the 2005 Polaris Snowmobile referenced hereinabove to Silver Valley Search & Rescue.


RESOLUTION - 1
