

**Resolution 2021-47  
Destroy Records/Treasurer**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners and

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain county records has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of these records has been received; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the records of the Kootenai County Treasurer's Office included in Exhibit "A" attached, which are dated before 2018 which were classified in Resolution 2021-46, are authorized to be destroyed.



Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:




