

**Resolution 2021-108**  
**Vehicle License Fee Increase/Assessor**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §63-1311A provides for the increase of fees by the Assessor for vehicle licensing; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* 63-1311A states that no fee increase over 5% can be changed until a public hearing has been held; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* 63-1311A states “a board of county commissioners may impose and collect fees for those services provided by the county which would otherwise be funded by ad valorem tax revenues. The fees collected pursuant to this section shall be reasonably related to, but shall not exceed, the actual cost of the service being rendered” and,

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Assessor’s Office requested the Auditor’s Office to analyze the fee of \$2.50 charged as an admin fee per vehicle registration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Auditor’s Office found potential for increasing the fee. The revenue required from the vehicle admin fee to cover the expenses not covered by other revenue would need to be \$5.09 per registration, which is over the current fee of \$2.50; and

**WHEREAS**, according to the information provided by the Assessor’s Office, Kootenai County has the lowest admin fee in the state and was last update in the 1980’s; and

**WHEREAS**, an updated resolution is needed to reflect those changes; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-710 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to establish such fees; and

**WHEREAS**, all notices required by law have been made and/or published in the Coeur d’Alene Press on October 18, 2021 and October 25, 2021;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the fee for Vehicle Licensing be \$5.09 per registration effective as of November 2, 2021.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:





