

**Resolution 2021-111
Destroy Records/Treasurer**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of these records has been received; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Treasurer's Office included in Exhibit "A" attached, which are dated between 1989 - 2015 which were classified in Resolution 2021-110, are authorized to be destroyed.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the records shall be under the direction and supervision of the Clerk of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


