

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-122
RETIREMENT OF SHERIFF'S K-9

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County;

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment, is of no further use to the county, he may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff has in his possession one (1) trained law enforcement K-9 by the name of Dyno; and

WHEREAS, Dyno has been with the Kootenai County Sheriff since 2019 and is now medically unable to further serve as a law enforcement K-9; and

WHEREAS, due to the special nature of Dyno's training he cannot be sold or given away as a family pet; and

WHEREAS, Dyno's value is under \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff desires to have Dyno classified as surplus property and retired.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Dyno, shall be retired from the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department K-9 unit, and in the best interests of his health and well-being he shall be sold to his handler, Deputy Arek Brock, for one dollar (\$1.00) in a private sale, and Dyno shall live out his retirement as a pet in consideration of his loyal service to Kootenai County.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, and seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


