

**Resolution 2020-28**  
**Advisory Vote on Urban Renewal Districts**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KOOTENAI COUNTY**, of Idaho, as follows:

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County, Idaho, is a County created and operating under the laws of the State of Idaho; and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Statute 31-718 gives the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners the authority to place a question on the ballot pertaining to any issue before the citizens of that county; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners to submit before the voters of Kootenai County an advisory vote on the issue of Urban Renewal Districts; and

**WHEREAS**, the language on the ballot shall state:

“Do you support the use of Urban Renewal Districts (URDs) in Kootenai County? Prior and current examples include: Cabela’s, Health District Corridor, Kroc Center, Riverstone, McEuen Park”

Yes  No ; and




