

Resolution 2020-36
**Homeowners' Exemption/Property Tax Relief/
VA Application Deadline Extension**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §§63-701 through 63-711 sets forth the governing law relating to property tax relief; and

WHEREAS, in order for Circuit Breaker (PTR) and VA applicants to receive a benefit, they must be the property owner occupant with a current Homeowners Exemption; and

WHEREAS, due to the Governor's extension of the Circuit Breaker (PTR) and VA benefit application deadline to June 15th, there is a potential conflict with the existing Homeowner's Exemption application deadline of April 15th; and

WHEREAS, as of 2020 it is possible for a PTR/VA applicant to apply between April 16th and June 15th without having met the April 15th Homeowners' Exemption deadline, thus not receiving the benefit due to limitations with the current County system; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to provide for a Homeowner's Exemption application deadline from April 15th to June 15th to only those property owners that qualify for the Circuit Breaker (PTR) or Veterans 100% Service-Connected Disability;


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the deadline for Homeowner's Exemption be extended from April 15th to June 15th to allow for Circuit Breaker (PTR) and Veterans to apply in a timely manner.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


