

RESOLUTION 2020-39

**COEUR D'ALENE AIRPORT/DEFERRAL OF FUEL
FLOWAGE FEE PAYMENTS**

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §§21-401 and 31-870 provide that counties may fix fees to charge for use of their airports and related facilities; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution 2019-40 on April 23, 2019, which established a fee schedule and authorized Airport staff to collect the appropriate fees from Airport tenants to support operations and maintenance of the Coeur d'Alene Airport; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution 2019-11 on February 26, 2019, which established the 2019 Airport Minimum Rules and Standards as the governing authority for all aeronautical activities undertaken at the Coeur d'Alene Airport, with such authority addressing fuel flowage fees; and,

WHEREAS, all Airport leases entered into between a tenant and the County include a provision which requires the tenant to pay fuel flowage fees when leasing Coeur d'Alene Airport property and requires the tenant to comply with the Airport Minimum Rules and Standards then in effect; and,

WHEREAS, fuel flowage fees are assessed against any tenant, fueler and/or SASO authorized to conduct Commercial Self-Service Fueling facilities or fueling operations on the Airport from which revenue is derived. Such fees are calculated on a per gallon basis at the rates established in the effective fee schedule and then paid by the tenant, fueler and/or SASO directly to the Coeur d'Alene Airport; and,

WHEREAS, due to the recent COVID-19 pandemic and the economic impact it has had on the local economy, many of the tenants of the Coeur d'Alene Airport have encountered a reduction in operation and revenues which has created an economic hardship; and,

WHEREAS, the tenants affected by the economic impact of COVID-19 have requested to defer payment of their fuel flowage fees in order to allow the economy to bounce back and provide them a reasonable period of time to return to normal business activities; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believes that it would be in the best interest of the County to work with the tenants and allow them additional time to pay their fuel flowage fees in order to maintain the long-standing business relationship it has had with its tenants.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners does hereby defer payment of any fuel flowage fees incurred by the tenants of the Kootenai County Airport between May 1, 2020 and July 31, 2020, until August 1, 2020.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all fuel flowage fees calculated and accrued in the normal course of business between May 1, 2020 and July 31, 2020, must be paid and brought current by the tenant on or before August 1, 2020.
