

**Resolution 2020-32**

**Advisory Vote on Community Reentry Center (Prison Release Facility)**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KOOTENAI COUNTY,** of Idaho, as follows:

**WHEREAS,** Kootenai County, Idaho, is a County created and operating under the laws of the State of Idaho; and,

**WHEREAS,** Idaho Statute 31-718 gives the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners the authority to place a question on the ballot pertaining to any issue before the citizens of that county; and,

**WHEREAS,** it is the desire of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners to submit before the voters of Kootenai County an advisory vote on the issue of establishing a Community Reentry Center (Prison Release Facility) within Kootenai County; and,

**WHEREAS,** the language on the ballot shall state:

Do you support the establishment of a Community Reentry Center (Prison Release Facility) within Kootenai County?

Yes  No ; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED** that the above advisory vote on a prison release center shall be submitted to the Kootenai County Electorate for their opinion on the May 19, 2020 ballot for the primary election; and,
