

Resolution 2020-41

Acceptance of Donation – NAPA Tool Box Set and “A” Frame Hoist with ½ Ton Jet Electric Chain Hoist

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to receive real and personal property in donation, and to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Phil Cummings is the owner of a NAPA Tool Box Set which includes one 9-drawer top box, one 15-drawer bottom box, and one 8-drawer side box, and an “A” Frame Hoist, #20453, purchased from Hanson Industries, and one ½ ton Jet Electric Chain Hoist, #J390969012, manufactured by Hitachi Ltd., which property presently has an estimated cumulative value of \$2,500; and,

WHEREAS, Phil Cummings has offered to gift/donate the property referenced hereinabove to Kootenai County for use at the aviation field located at the Kootenai County Airport; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Airport could utilize the property referenced hereinabove in its normal course of business at its aviation field.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Kootenai County does hereby accept the gift/donation of the property referenced hereinabove on behalf of the Kootenai County Airport.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the property referenced hereinabove shall be assigned an asset tag and added to Kootenai County’s list of assets as maintained by the Kootenai County Clerk/Auditor in its regular course of business.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Brooks, seconded by Commissioner Duncan, the following vote was recorded:


