

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-60
EXCHANGE OR TRADE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY
KOOTENAI COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has in its possession the following rifles and pistols, together with associated accessories:

- (1) Fourteen (14) RAP4 Automatic Paintball Rifles identified with the following serial numbers: 110033, 105431, 105404, 105601, 105940, 110270, 106219, 110342, 105559, 105582, 105395, 110077, 105437, and 110020;
- (2) 69 Automatic Paintball Rifle Magazines;
- (3) Eight (8) RAP4 Combat Paintball Pistols identified with the following serial numbers: RC09E005563, RC09D03685, RC09E05631, RC11I08673, RC11I08726, RC11J08825, RC09D03713, and RC09E05028;
- (4) Eighteen pistol magazines;
- (5) 192 CO2 cartridges;
- (6) Approximately 4000 paintball rounds;
- (7) Approximately 4000 reusable RAP4 rounds; and
- (8) One (1) tool kit with repair supplies.

WHEREAS, the rifles, pistols and accessories identified above were purchased approximately 10 years ago, the specific dates for such purchases are unknown. The rifles and pistols were utilized several years prior as training weapons by Sheriff's Office personnel in the course and scope of their law enforcement duties; and

WHEREAS, the rifles, pistols and associated accessories identified above are of no further use to law enforcement, as they have been in storage for many years after having been replaced by newer and more advanced training weapons; and

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WHEREAS, Sheriff's Office personnel had the rifles, pistols and associated accessories inspected and valued by a local gun dealer, and the dealer has established that the cumulative approximate value of the equipment is \$1,950; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Sheriff's Office personnel to trade the rifles, pistols and associated accessories identified above for suppressor heat covers, as the rifles, pistols and associated accessories would have a greater value on trade for other needed law enforcement equipment than upon auction and/or private sale; and,

WHEREAS, Protection First, a gun dealer located at 1403 N. Greene Street, Suite 2, Spokane, Washington, has offered to take the identified rifles, pistols and associated accessories in trade for suppressor heat covers; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consents to the trade of the rifles, pistols and associated accessories as described hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to use the rifles, pistols and associated accessories as identified hereinabove as trade for the new suppressor heat covers offered through Protection First.


