

Resolution 2020-63
Surplus Equipment /Asset Deletion/Juvenile Detention

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Detention has in its possession one (1) 1995 Chevrolet S-10 Pickup, Asset No. 1953; Vehicle License No C8106 which is currently not usable and, due to age, is not able to be repaired and has outlived its usefulness to the County; and

WHEREAS, the equipment is in poor condition and its total value is in excess of \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Detention desires to have the above-referenced equipment declared as surplus property; deleted from the County's asset list, and disposed of pursuant to law;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public sale in accordance with Idaho law and remove the same from the County's list of assets.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:




