

Resolution 2020-68
Surplus Equipment and Asset Deletion/Juvenile Detention

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property not exceeding \$250.00 in value be sold through a private sale without notice or public auction; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Detention has in its possession one (1) Fingerprinting Set with box, Asset tag #3583; one (1) M&E Audio & Visual – TV/VCR/Projector, Asset tag #2683 and one (1) Catalyst 3560X 48 port LAN Base Router, Asset tag #6010 which are obsolete due to age, inoperable and not repairable, and/or are fully depreciated, and therefore have outlived their useful life for the Department and are of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total value of the equipment is less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Detention desires to have the above referenced property declared as surplus property, deleted from its asset list, and disposed of;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the items referenced hereinabove be, and hereby are, removed from the County's list of assets and declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said items by public or private sale, or by other means, in accordance with Idaho law.

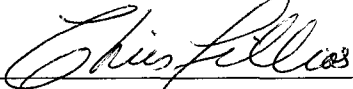
Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:

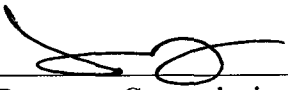
