

**Resolution 2020-69**  
**Alternative Forms of County Government**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-5001 and 31-5801 provide for alternative forms of county government; and,

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-5101 allows for the appointment of a Study Commission to investigate and report as to alternative forms of county government; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners wish to appoint a Commission to study the existing form of county government, to compare to all other forms established under *Idaho Code* §31-5001, *et. seq.*, and *Idaho Code* title 31, chapters 54 through 58, and such study commission shall therefore conduct business in accordance with the requirements of *Idaho Code* title 31 Chapter 51, and as lawfully directed by the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners:


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** as follows: that the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners appoint a Study Commission consisting of nine (9) members, and to conduct a study and report to the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners as required by Idaho law, and as further lawfully directed.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Brooks, seconded by Commissioner Duncan, the following vote was recorded:


Commissioner Brooks:	Aye
