

Resolution 2020-76
Destroy Records/Parks and Waterways

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code* provides for the classification of records as permanent, semi-permanent, or temporary and destruction thereof; and

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code* requires the Resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain records of the Parks and Waterways Department was performed, and legal advice having been sought and given, regarding the disposal of certain records; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that certain records of the Parks and Waterways Department, specifically identified in Resolution 2020-76 and Exhibit "A" thereto, have surpassed the respective statutory retention periods for public records of their nature, and therefore may be destroyed.




Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:


