

Resolution 2020-102
Destroy Records/Office of Emergency Management

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code* provides for the classification of records as permanent, semi-permanent, or temporary and destruction thereof; and

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code* requires a Resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain records of the Office of Emergency Management was performed, and legal advice having been sought and given, regarding the disposal of certain records; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that certain records of the Office of Emergency Management, specifically identified in Resolution 2020-101 and Exhibit "A" thereto, have surpassed the respective statutory retention periods for public records of their nature, and therefore may be destroyed.


