

**Resolution 2020-99
Surplus Weapons/KCSO**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property not exceeding \$250.00 in value may be sold at private sale without notice or public auction; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has in its possession one (1) Remington 870 12 gage shotgun, serial number RS01832P, and one (1) Bushmaster M4-16 .223 rifle, serial number ARG504526, which due to a fire have been damaged beyond repair and have no useful value for the County; and

WHEREAS, each of the weapons described hereinabove have no value and would be of no benefit to other County Departments; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office desires to have the above-referenced property declared as surplus property, disposed of pursuant to law, and removed from the County's list of assets;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the items described hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may donate or destroy one (1) Remington 870 12 gage shotgun, serial number RS01832P, and one (1) Bushmaster M4-16 .223 rifle, serial number ARG504526, and remove the same from the County's list of assets.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:
