

Resolution 2019-09
Adjust Taxes to Reflect Circuit Breaker

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners received a request for reduction of the 2018 taxes on the above referenced parcel number, record owner being Wesley P. Fauver, 2123 W. Pellinore Way, Post Falls, Idaho 83854; and

WHEREAS, Kandi Chandler, daughter and attorney in fact for Mr. Fauver, requested the reduction of the 2018 taxes to reflect the Circuit Breaker on the referenced parcel as Mr. Fauver, suffers from age related ailments and failed to apply for the program in 2018; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Fauver, upon receiving the tax bill, paid the entire amount, assuming the circuit breaker was reflected, subsequently causing financial hardship; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners on January 2, 2019 at a properly noticed public meeting, agreed to adjust the taxes for 2018 to reflect the circuit breaker received in 2017 and refund the additional amount paid provided the circuit breaker paperwork is submitted immediately; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the taxes for the 2018 tax year be adjusted to reflect the circuit breaker received in 2017 and refund the additional amount paid; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Assessor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said Resolution.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Bingham, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:




