

**Resolution 2019-16**  
**Surplus Equipment and Asset Deletion/Auditor**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property not exceeding \$250.00 in value be sold through a private sale without notice or public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Auditor's Department has in its possession one (1) RICOH Aficia MPC2800 Copier, Asset Tag #4728 which is obsolete due to age, inoperable and not repairable, and/or are fully depreciated, and therefore has outlived their useful life for the Department and is of no further use to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the estimated total value of the equipment is less than \$250.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Auditor's Department desires to have the above referenced property declared as surplus property, deleted from its asset list, and disposed of;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, removed from the County's list of assets and declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by other means, in accordance with Idaho law.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Brooks, seconded by Commissioner Duncan, the following vote was recorded:


