

**RESOLUTION 2019-20**  
**SALE OF K-9 Axo**

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Sheriff Ben Wolfinger has requests authorization to dispose of certain personal property belonging to Kootenai County under his jurisdiction and control, to wit: one (1) retired police dog named "Axo" with a present value of less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), and;

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Sheriff has arranged for the private sale of K-9 Axo to Deputy Jason Shaw, a qualified individual, for the reason that Deputy Shaw is no longer a member of the K9 Unit.

**WHEREAS**, Deputy Jason Shaw, the former owner and present handler of K-9 Axo, has the right of first refusal to reclaim ownership of said K-9 Axo, pursuant to an Agreement between Kootenai County and Deputy Jason Shaw entered into on June 12, 2018; and,

**WHEREAS**, Deputy Jason Shaw, has expressed a willingness to assume ownership and full responsibility of K-9 Axo and is uniquely qualified to care for K-9 Axo.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that Kootenai County Sheriff Ben Wolfinger has the consent of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners to sell K-9 Axo to Deputy Jason Shaw for \$1.00, pursuant to the June 12, 2018 Agreement; and,

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that the transfer of ownership and full responsibility of K-9 Axo shall take place by formal Bill of Sale.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Brooks, seconded by Commissioner Duncan, the following vote was recorded:




