

Resolution 2019-25
Destroy Records/Noxious Weed Control

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code* provides for the classification of records as permanent, semi-permanent, or temporary and destruction thereof; and

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code* requires the Resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain records of the Kootenai County Noxious Weed Control Department was performed, and legal advice having been sought and given, regarding the disposal of certain records.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that certain records of the Kootenai County Noxious Weed Control Department, specifically identified in Resolution 2019-24 and Exhibit "A" thereto, have surpassed the statutory retention period for public records of this nature, and therefore may be destroyed.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the original records referenced hereinabove be done under the direction and supervision of the Director of the Noxious Weed Control Department.
