

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-26
EXCHANGE OR TRADE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has in its possession seven (7) used 9mm Heckler & Koch MP5 Rifles, bearing serial numbers 62-344439, 62-350893, 62-352025, 62-366145, 62-367832, 62-367833 and 63-99256, together with associated accessories including slings, cases and magazine. Six (6) of the rifles were purchased between 1990 and 1997 and one (1) was purchased in 2008. The rifles were being utilized by Sheriff's Office personnel in the course and scope of their law enforcement duties; and,

WHEREAS, the MP5 Rifles have been replaced with newer and more advanced multipurpose short and long range rifle models, rendering the MP5 Rifles to be of no further use to law enforcement; and,

WHEREAS, Sheriff's Office personnel had the MP5 Rifles and associated accessories inspected and valued by a local gun dealer, and the dealer has established that the approximate value of each of the MP5 Rifles is \$850, including accessories; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Sheriff's Office personnel to trade the MP5 Rifles described hereinabove for new rifle suppressors, as the rifles would have a greater value on trade for other needed law enforcement equipment than upon auction and/or private sale; and,

WHEREAS, Protection First, a gun dealer located at 1403 N. Greene Street, Suite 2, Spokane, Washington, has offered to take the MP5 Rifles and associated accessories in trade for fourteen (14) new rifle suppressors; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consents to the trade of the seven (7) MP5 Rifles and associated accessories as described hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to use the seven (7) 9mm Heckler & Koch MP5 Rifles and associated accessories identified above as trade for the fourteen (14) new rifle suppressors offered through Protection First.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, and seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


