

**Resolution 2019-29**  
**Destroy Records/Parks & Waterways**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 provides for the classification of records as permanent, semi-permanent, or temporary and destruction thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the Resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain records of the Parks and Waterways Department was performed, and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of certain records;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that certain records of the Parks and Waterways Department, specifically identified in Resolution 2019-28 and Exhibit "A" thereto, have surpassed the statutory retention period for public records of this nature, and therefore may be destroyed.




Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Fillios, the following vote was recorded:
