WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, Custody Division, have been performed and legal service having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;



Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, and seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:




