

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-55
EXCHANGE OR TRADE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has in its possession five (5) dry dive suits more particularly described as follows:

Diving DUI 350 – Blue – Size XL
Diving DUI 350 – Red – Size XL
Diving TLS 350 – Teal – Size L
Diving TLS 350 – Red – Size XXL
Diving DUI 350 – Red – Size XL

The dry suits are identified on the Kootenai County Auditor's Asset Data Sheets, copies of which attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof by reference;

WHEREAS, the dive suits were purchased through Tom's Diving in 1995, 1997 and 1999, and were available to the dive team as spares in the event of emergency situations which arose in the course and scope of their law enforcement duties. All but one of the dive suits are over 20 years old, and all have been out of service and held in storage as part of the dive team inventory for over 10 years;

WHEREAS, the dive suits have no appreciable value in today's market, and pursuant to industry standards are no longer considered safe and usable in a public safety diver environment due to their age. Therefore, the dive suits are of no further use to the dive team;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Sheriff's Office personnel to trade the aging dive suits described hereinabove for a new dive suit, as the aging suits would have a greater value on trade than upon auction and/or private sale;

WHEREAS, Jake Powlison, the owner and operator of Jake's Scuba Adventures, 1308 E. Best Avenue, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, has offered to take the five (5) dive suits in trade for one new Waterproof D7X dry suit valued at \$2,899.00;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consents to the trade of the five (5) dive suits as described hereinabove.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to use the five (5) dive suits identified above as trade for a new Waterproof D7X dry suit offered through Jake's Scuba Adventures.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, and seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


Commissioner Brooks: Aye


