

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-56
EXCHANGE OR TRADE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Adult Misdemeanor Probation has in its possession nine pistols more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, seven of the pistols (those with serial numbers beginning in WNZ) were ordered through G.W., Inc. on January 17, 2014, and the remaining two pistols (those with serial numbers beginning in YBX) were ordered through the same vendor on May 18, 2015. These pistols were issued as duty weapons and carried by the County's Adult Misdemeanor Probation officers for use in the course and scope of their enforcement duties; and,

WHEREAS, three of the nine pistols are presently being used by probation officers, and the remaining six are out of service due to their grip size and caliber; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Adult Misdemeanor Probation personnel has consulted with a local dealer regarding the value of the nine pistols referenced above, and the dealer has established that the approximate trade-in value of two of the pistols is \$300 each, and the trade-in value of the remaining seven pistols is \$275 each, for a total trade-in value of \$2525.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Kootenai County Adult Misdemeanor Probation personnel to trade in the nine pistols referenced above in exchange for credit of \$2,525 to be applied towards the purchase of five new Glock Gen-5 G45 MOS, 9mm pistols and associated equipment, as these pistols would better fit the probation officers for use as duty weapons in the field, and the same would have a greater value on trade than upon auction and/or private sale; and,

WHEREAS, David Henry, sales person at GW-LE, Gunarama Wholesale Inc., 4009 E. Mission Avenue, Spokane, Washington, 99202, has offered to take the nine Glock GEN-4 G21-45ACP pistols in trade and provide the sum of \$2,525 as credit to be applied against the purchase price of five new pistols, each valued at \$501.

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consents to the trade of the nine pistols as described hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Kootenai County Adult Misdemeanor Probation personnel is hereby authorized to use the nine pistols identified above as trade for the purchase of five new pistols through GW-LE, Gunarama Wholesale Inc.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, and seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


