

Resolution 2019-60
**Destroy Records/Background Files/Applications/
Applicants Not Selected for Hire**
April 2013 – April 2015

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office have been performed and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office related to Background Files and Applications of Applicants not Selected for Hire April 2013 to April 2015 have surpassed the statutory retention period as public records and therefore may be destroyed.



Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


