

**Resolution 2019-72**  
**Capital Asset Deletion/KCSO**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County, and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property classified as being under \$250.00 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has on its Capital Asset list (Exhibit "A") items which due to age are inoperable, obsolete, and/or previously disposed of, and therefore are of no further use to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office desires to have the items listed on Exhibit "A" removed from the County's asset list;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the items referenced hereinabove, are valueless, obsolete and disposed of and shall be removed from the County's list of assets.

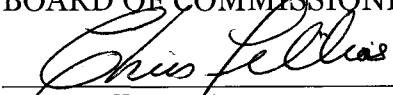
Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:

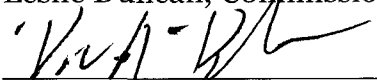

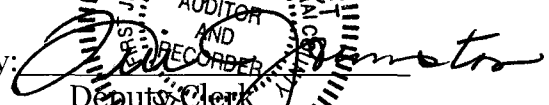
