

Resolution 2019-65
Surplus Equipment and Asset Deletion/Juvenile Detention

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-808 provides that property not exceeding \$250.00 in value may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Detention has in its possession one (1) Ricoh Afficio SP3510 DN Printer, Asset Tag #5968 which is obsolete due to age, inoperable and not repairable, and/or is fully depreciated, and therefore outlived its useful life and is of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the estimated total value of the equipment is less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Juvenile Detention desires to have the above referenced property declared as surplus property, disposed of pursuant to law, and deleted from the County's asset list;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the item referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said item by public or private sale, or by other means in accordance with Idaho law, and remove the same from the County's list of assets.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:
