

Resolution 2019-66
Exchange or Trade of Personal Property

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Buildings & Grounds Department has in its possession one (1) Curtis Plow, Asset #4134 and one (1) John Deere Loader, Asset #3600 identified on the Kootenai County Auditor's Asset Data Sheets, copies of which attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof by reference;

WHEREAS, the equipment referenced above is obsolete due to age, and fully depreciated, and therefore outlived it's useful life and is of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Buildings & Grounds Department to apply the value of the equipment described hereinabove to the purchase of an Aren's snow blower;

WHEREAS, Ragan Equipment, Coeur d' Alene, Idaho has offered to take in trade the Curtis Plow for a value of \$850.00 and John Deere Loader for a value of \$450.00 for an Aren's snow blower valued at \$1,349.00 leaving a balance owed of \$49.00;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consents to the trade in of the equipment described hereinabove;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Buildings & Grounds Department is hereby authorized to apply the value of the Curtis Plow and John Deere Loader to the cost of an Aren's snow blower offered through Ragan Equipment.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, and seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:




