

**Resolution 2019-75**  
**Spirit Lake No Wake Zone/Parks and Waterways Department**

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §67-7031(3) vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to adopt local ordinances regarding the operation of vessels on any waters within its territorial limits, provided the ordinances are intended to promote or protect the health, safety, and general welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §67-7031(4) vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to adopt ordinances establishing operational zones for personal watercraft on any waters within its territorial limits, to include “no wake or less than five (5) miles per hour” zones; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that a no wake zone is appropriate in the narrow channel immediately south of the Sportsman’s Access Public Boat Launch, Spirit Lake, Kootenai County;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the following area shall be designated as a restricted zone in Kootenai County, Idaho, as defined in County Code §6-2-6(A)(3) as follows:

**RESTRICTED ZONE**

- I. No Wake Zone
  - a. The waterway south of the boat launch until said channel opens to a width of more than 895 feet across, at the Sportsman’s Access public boat launch, Spirit Lake.
  - b. The end of the No Wake Zone shall be designated by an encroachment in aid of navigation, to-wit: a buoy indicating “End No Wake Zone.”


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:




