

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-85
EXCHANGE OR TRADE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade-in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements;

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has in its possession four (4) older model Swat Rifles, more particularly described as follows:

Grizzle/Mega Arms 6.8 Rem. Special – Serial No. MBM1652
Grizzle/Mega Arms 6.8 Rem. Special – Serial No. MBM1653
Ruger M77 Mark II Bolt Action Rifle – Serial No. 786-70541
Ruger M77 Mark II Bolt Action Rifle – Serial No. 786-70587

The two Grizzle/Mega Arms 6.8 Rem. Specials were purchased in 2013 at a price of \$3,200 each. Sheriff's Office staff has been unable to locate paperwork as to the purchase date and purchase price of the two Ruger M77 Mark II Bolt Action Rifles but indicate that the Rugers are much older than the Remington Specials; and,

WHEREAS, upon acquisition, the four (4) rifles referenced above were utilized by Sheriff's Office personnel in the course and scope of their law enforcement duties; however, the rifles have been replaced over the years with newer and more advanced models, rendering the rifles to be of no further use to law enforcement. The rifles have been maintained in storage for many years; and,

WHEREAS, Sheriff's Office personnel had the four (4) rifles inspected and valued by Triple B Guns, a local gun dealer, and the dealer has established that the approximate value of each of the Ruger M77 rifles is \$500, and the approximate value of each of the Grizzle 6.8 Remington Specials is \$1,000; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Sheriff's Office personnel to trade the four (4) rifles described hereinabove for one (1) new Ruger Precision Rifle, 300 Win Mag caliber, complete with optics, bipod and sling, which has a present value of \$3,000, as the four (4) rifles would have a greater value on trade than upon auction and/or private sale; and,

WHEREAS, Innovation Ammunition Technologies, a gun dealer located at 15450 W. Frost Road, Worley, Idaho, 83876, has offered to take the four (4) rifles in as trade for the new Ruger Precision Rifle, 300 Win Mag caliber, and associated optics, bipod and sling; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consents to the trade of the four (4) rifles as described hereinabove.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to use the four (4) rifles described hereinabove as trade for the new Ruger Precision Rifle, 300 Win Mag caliber, and associated optics, bipod and sling which is being offered through Innovation Ammunition Technologies.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, and seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:
