

**Resolution 2019-88**  
**Destroy Records/KCSO/9-1-1**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office, 9-1-1 Division, having been performed and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;


**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Media Record Requests from 2011-2015 previously classified as temporary records by Resolution 2019-87 shall be destroyed under the direction and supervision of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, and seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:


