

Resolution 2019-94
Donate Surplus Property/Airport

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 provides that property being donated “after adoption of this resolution by the Board of County Commissioners that the grant or exchange of property is in the public interest”; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Airport has on its asset list (exhibit “A”) items which due to age are obsolete, and no longer cost effective to operate, and therefore are of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Airport desires to have the items listed on exhibit “A” removed from the county asset list and donated to the following public airports:

- One (1) International dump/plow truck, asset tag #1043/VIN #1HTAA1955EHA12911 to Bonner County Airport
- One (1) Speeflo paint machine, asset tag #7782/SEA #0823310017 to Bonner County Airport
- One (1) Kubota mower, asset tag #1050/SEA #12404 to Colfax Airport

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the items referenced hereinabove, are valueless, obsolete and shall be removed from the County’s list of assets and donated in the public interest.
