

**Resolution 2019-98
Destroy Records/Office of Emergency Management**

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code*, provides for the classification of records as permanent, semi-permanent, or temporary and the destruction thereof; and

WHEREAS, section 31-871, *Idaho Code*, requires a Resolution ordering the destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, the records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain records of the Office of Emergency Management has been performed and legal advice having been sought and given, regarding the disposal of these records; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Office of Emergency Management, specifically identified in Resolution 2019-97 and Exhibit "A" thereto, have surpassed the statutory retention period for public records of this nature, and therefore may be destroyed.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the records shall be under the direction and supervision of the Director of the Office of Emergency Management.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Brooks, seconded by Commissioner Duncan, the following vote was recorded:


