

Resolution 2019-99
Purchase of Goods and Services on Open Market/ Parks and Waterways

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §67-2805(2) sets forth the procedures applicable to the procurement of public works construction valued in excess of \$200,000.00 via a competitive sealed bid process; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department sought to procure the construction and installation of a breakwater at the Harrison Marina pursuant to *Idaho Code* §67-2805(2)(a) by soliciting competitive sealed bids in Bid No. 2019-15; and

WHEREAS, the sole bid received in response to the Bid No. 2019-15 solicitation was significantly higher than the cost estimated and said bid was rejected by the Board of County Commissioners at the public Business Meeting on or about November 12, 2019; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §67-2805(2)(a)(viii) authorizes the Board of Commissioners, in its discretion, to find that a project sought to be accomplished by the expenditure can be performed more economically by purchasing goods and services on the open market, and to adopt a Resolution declaring the same; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners hereby finds that purchasing the goods and services for the public works construction and installation of a new breakwater at the Harrison Marina can be performed more economically on the open market;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Department be, and hereby is, declared to be authorized to purchase the goods and services for the public works construction and installation of a new breakwater at the Harrison Marina on the open market.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Duncan, seconded by Commissioner Brooks, the following vote was recorded:




