

**Resolution 2018-12  
Destroy Records/Board of Commissioners**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain county records maintained by Kootenai County Assistance has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of these records has been received; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 31-871A allows for the retention of records in an alternative medium and destruction of the originals;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the original physical county records which were recorded in the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners' Office, as identified on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, and as classified in Resolution No. 2016-48 as *semi-permanent records*, are authorized to be retained in an alternative medium pursuant to *Idaho Code* § 31-871A, and that the originals may be destroyed.

**FURTHER** that the destruction and disposition of the original records of the case files referenced hereinabove be done under the direction and supervision of the Kootenai County Clerk.


Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Fillios, seconded by Commissioner Bingham, the following vote was recorded:
